## PROCEDURE FOR EUTHANASIA

In the unfortunate event that euthanasia of one of the Club's horses requires euthanasia, the following procedure is to be followed.

- 1. Is this a planned euthanasia?
- 2. Is it an emergency eg broken leg?
- 3. Contact the horse's owners if they are not already present.
- 4. Make sure owners' preference for euthanasia is followed.
- 5. If planned euthanasia, make sure it is planned for a quiet time at the yard.
- 6. Have disposal services ready to take the body away.
- 7. Take horse / pony to a quiet area, away from general public.
- 8. Allow only those the horse / pony feels safe and secure with to accompany them.
- 9. Keep calm at all times around the horse / pony.
- 10. Allow the professional to do their job swiftly.
- 11. Cover the body with tarpaulin if disposal services are unable to take the body away immediately.
- 12. Once the body has gone, wash floor down to remove all traces of blood.
- 13. Tidy up area.
- 14. If staff accompanied the horse, allow time for them to get over the upset.
- 15. If owners were present, make sure they safe to drive before letting them leave the yard.
